*Children's Chapel Monitor	Help supervise and engage children in an activity, with the help of others. This is our summer children's program and a few others each year.										
Summer Program Planning	Work with the DRE and a Team to plan and coordinate the Summer Program. 1-3 meetings										
*Summer Program Presenter	Share a Ministry that is important to you. The schedule is flexible, and it's a great way to get to know the children!										
*Nursery Volunteer	Volunteer one or more times each month, helping one of our staff members.										
*Children's Choir Assistant	Assist the Director with Children's Choir during the regular R.E. time one Sunday each Month										
Flower Communion & Egg Hunt	Be part of the team to plan, set up and run the egg hunt and the luncheon on Easter Sunday										
Kitchen Angel	Set up, Prepare food, clean up (choose one or more) in the kitchen for special R.E. events at Live Oak										
Water & Bubble Day	Be part of the team to plan, set up, run Live Oak's annual Children's event which occurs during the R.E. Time the last Sunday in August
